### CPS Selective Enrollment Exam

- \* CPS does not release specific details regarding the number of questions and time for each test.
- -Test is timed
- -No Penalty for guessing
- -No calculator may be used (UNLESS specified by current IEP/504)
- -Make sure IEP/504 is current and includes all necessary accommodations. Submit to student's school counselor.

### Independent School (ISEE)

- -Test is designed for multiple grade levels (ex. 8th-11th). Students will only be scored against other students in their grade level.
- -Multiple testing dates throughout the year
- -Test is timed
- -No Penalty for guessing

## Chicago High School Entrance Exams

-Accommodations will be made but paperwork (504/IEP) must be submitted 5 weeks prior to test date. Submit by fax, email, or upload to student's ISEE online account with Testing with Accommodations Form.

#### Catholic School Test

- Test is open to current 8th grade students
- There is only one testing date per year (in January)
- Test must be taken at the school the student is interested in attending
- No penalty for guessing
- Only time accommodation will be given. Student must bring a copy of their IEP/504 plan on test day when they register.
